Guest WiFi Acceptable Use Policy

Matthew Moss High School provides a guest wireless network for short-term access that is accessible to guests with compatible wireless devices.

This network has limited access to Matthew Moss High School systems and services and is therefore not intended for use by MMHS community members.

This is an unencrypted wireless service.

Only current guests of Matthew Moss High School may use this service. By clicking your acceptance or by accessing or using this service, you represent that you are currently a guest of the school and acknowledge that you have read all of the terms and conditions of this agreement, understand them, and agree to be legally bound by them.

MM-Guest Terms and Conditions of Use

Welcome to the guest wireless high-speed Internet access system ("MM-Guest") at Matthew Moss High School ("MMHS"). These "Terms and Conditions of Use", govern your rights and responsibilities and our rights and responsibilities relating to the use of the MM-Guest at MMHS.

Acceptance of Terms and Conditions of Use

By clicking on "Logon" on the MM-Guest sign-up page, you represent that:

1. You have read, understand and agree to the terms of this agreement

AND

2. You are at least 18 years of age*

If you do not agree to the terms of this Agreement, or if you are not 18 years of age or older, you may not use the MM-Guest. Your electronic acceptance of the Agreement by clicking on "Logon" on the sign-up page has the same effect as if you had actually signed the Agreement. The effective date of this Agreement is the date that you click on "Logon."

*Certain groups utilizing or invited to the MMHS campus with those under the age of 18 may be granted permission to use MM-Guest. Such access must be negotiated with MMHS's IT Support Department.

Description of Wi-Fi System/Service Availability

MMHS will provide access to MM-Guest at locations ("Enabled Locations") that have been equipped with wireless access points. Access points or Enabled Locations may not be available in all areas of MMHS, and may not always be operational. The guest wireless network may be subject to periodic maintenance, unforeseen downtime, and limited availability.

Guest wireless access is provided as a free service on an "as is" basis with no guarantee of service.

Access to Internet

Whilst MMHS takes reasonable measures restrict access to inappropriate content placed on or accessible through the Internet, you acknowledge that if you access the Internet you may receive or be exposed to content, goods or services which you consider to be improper, inaccurate, misleading, defamatory, obscene or otherwise offensive. You agree that MMHS is not liable for any action or inaction with respect to any such content on the Internet accessible through the MM-Guest.

Your Responsibilities

Use of MM-Guest is undertaken at the user's own risk.

You must (1) provide all equipment (including computer hardware and software, wireless network cards, etc.) to connect to the MM-Guest, (2) comply with local, national and international laws and regulations, including but not limited to copyright and intellectual property rights laws. You agree to be responsible for and to bear all risk and consequences for (1) the accuracy, completeness, reliability and/or usefulness of any content available through the MM-Guest and (2) all communications that you send or receive via the MM-Guest. MMHS does not undertake the security of any data you send through the MM-Guest and it is your responsibility to secure such data.

MMHS assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment or device configurations, security, or data files resulting from connection to the MM-Guest or the Internet, nor liability for any damages to hardware, software or data, however caused. It is the responsibility of the user to protect their wireless devices through use of up-to-date virus protection, personal firewall and any other suitable measures.

MMHS staff will NOT assume any responsibility for personal hardware configurations, security or changes to data files resulting from connection to MM-Guest. It is recommended that users make a backup copy of any settings before configuring their equipment for use on MM-Guest.

Users are reminded that their use of the Internet will be directly traceable to our Internet address.

We therefore ask you not to visit sites which are:

- Illegal under current law
- Defamatory, threatening or intimidatory or which could be classed as harassment
- Contain obscene, profane or abusive language
- Contain pornographic material whether in writing, pictures, films or video clips
- Contain offensive material regarding sex, race, religion or any disability or sexual orientation
- Infringe third party rights or otherwise unlawful

Acceptable Use Policy

All users of MM-Guest must comply with this Acceptable Use Policy (AUP). This AUP is intended to prevent unacceptable uses of campus network. MMHS does not actively monitor the use of the Wi-Fi System under normal circumstances.

For quality assurance purposes, MMHS reserves the right to:

- Block internet services such as Peer-to-Peer and streaming video services
- Monitor usage of MM-Guest for quality assurance purposes

- Limit bandwidth on MM-Guest
 - Take any additional measures deemed necessary by MMHS in its sole discretion
- MMHS may cooperate with legal authorities and/or third parties in the investigation of any suspected or alleged crime or civil wrong. Violation of this AUP may result in the suspension or termination of your access to MM-Guest.
