# Home Learning Policy

## Statement

Learning beyond the classroom is a vital part of ensuring that our learners succeed. It helps teachers to maximise the learning time in class, and gives learners the opportunity to extend and deepen their understanding.

Learners will be given a variety of tasks to complete outside of lessons. These will be set at a level appropriate to their age and their current level of attainment to enable learners to achieve their potential.

## Expectation

Learners will receive at least once piece of home learning a week from each subject \*. The learning should take learners at least 30 minutes to complete and they have one week to complete the learning. All home learning has to be indicated in books and marked in accordance with the feedback policy.

Home Learning must be recorded in the Home Learning Log and Form Tutors must check this once a week.

## Responsibilities, Monitoring and Evaluation
